**AREA BOAT RAMPS** (all directions are based on departure from Kingsland Welcome Center unless otherwise noted)

**Crooked River State Park Boat Ramp** - East on Hwy40 3.6 miles, left on King's Bay Rd for 2.1 miles, left on GA Spur 40 for 4.2 miles to boat ramp located at the end of GA Spur 40.

**Harriett's Bluff Boat Ramp** - I-95 to Exit 7, turn east on Harriett's Bluff Rd approximately 7.2 miles & bear right at the fork, the ramp will be located on the left.

**Downtown St Mary's Waterfront Boat Ramp** - GA Hwy 40 east approximately 9 miles to St. Mary's St., turn right 0.1 miles to boat ramp located on left.

**North River Boat Ramp (Meeting Street Boat Ramp)** - Follow GA Hwy 40 East approximately 8 miles, turn left onto Meeting Street just past the railroad tracks (notice boat ramp sign) and the ramp is at the end of the road.

**Hwy 17 Bridge Boat Ramp** - Follow GA Hwy 40 West (East King Avenue) for approximately 1.5 miles, turn left onto U.S. Hwy 17/South Lee Street and travel approximately 3 miles. The landing is located on the left side of U.S. Hwy 17 just before the blue bridge at the Georgia/Florida state border.

**Temple Landing Boat Ramp** - Follow GA Hwy 40 West, approximately 6.3 miles and turn left at the flashing light onto Browntown Road. Travel approximately 0.8 miles and turn right at the four-way stop onto Greenville Road, turn at the first left onto Temple Landing Road and proceed for approximately 0.3 miles to the landing.

**Satilla River Waterfront Park & Boat Ramp** - This waterfront park is located in the town of Woodbine. From U.S. Hwy 17, turn east at the first road on the southern end of the bridge over the Satilla River (park is on the southeastern side of the Satilla River).

**Spring Bluff Boat Ramp, Little Satilla River-** Take I-95 north to Exit 14 at Woodbine, travel west on Spur 25/East 10th Street for approximately 2 miles, turn right on U.S. Hwy 17 for approximately 1 mile. The ramp is located north of Woodbine on U.S. Hwy 17 on the southeast side of the Little Satilla River Bridge.
