

WOODBINE RAIL-TRAIL

6+ Miles



3 RIVERS TRAIL

30 Miles

The 3 Rivers Trail in Camden County starts in historic downtown St Marys, follows the outer border of the Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay, passes by the Tabby Ruins and ends at Crooked River State Park. All or portions of the trail can be completed as desired with parking, rest stops and comfort stations located at the St Marys Waterfront Park, the Tabby Ruins and Crooked River State Park.







CUMBERLAND ISLAND NATIONAL SEASHORE

All of the roads on Cumberland Island are sandy surface and are often soft, making riding slower and more difficult. Bikes will need wider tires to be rideable. Bikes can be ridden on roads that are not marked private. Bikes cannot be on any trails but can be taken over to Sea Camp Campground. Bike riders should pull to the side of the road to allow vehicles to pass. Walk bikes when crossing boardwalks. All bikes are for adults and are located by Sea Camp. Rentals are managed by the Cumberland Island Ferry.

WHITE OAK RAIL TRAIL

6.1 Miles

White Oak sits just a couple of minutes north of Woodbine on Highway 17. The trailhead in White Oak is located at the post office at 25 McKinnon Road North. There is plenty of parking, a playground and picnic tables. This part of the rail trail is 3.1 miles and is gravel and crushed stone. It links the White Oak post office with the existing bridge on the abandoned rail corridor. Fishing is the main activity on the bridge. Both the White Oak & Woodbine Rail Trails are located west of I-95 near Highway 17.

LAUREL ISLAND PARKWAY

4.4 Miles

This trail was completed in 2021 and is a 4.4 miles long multi-use path. It runs parallel to Laurel Island Parkway Trail in Kingsland, Camden County. The hard-surface bike and pedestrian pathway was constructed as part of the parkway expansion project. The trail is part of the regional Three Rivers Trail, which will connect St. Marys, Woodbine and Crooked River State Park. The trail has also been designated part of the East Coast Greenway, which runs along the east coast of the US from Maine to Florida.

CROOKED RIVER STATE PARK

Crooked River State Park is located on the beautiful Crooked River and has approximately 1 mile of paved road in the park. The Palmetto Trail is approximately 1.5 miles long and is compiled of hard packed dirt. The Palmetto Trail highlights South Georgia's pine Flatwoods, one of the most endangered ecosystems in the world. The open woods are ideal for watching birds and spotting gopher tortoises. Standard or tandem bike rentals are available as well as bike seats and training wheels. A Georgia State Park pass is required.
